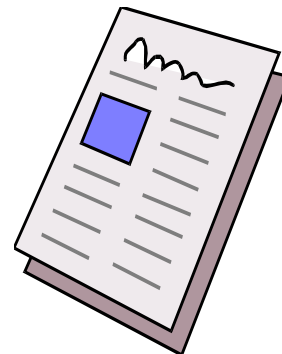

## What Does the Law Expect of Me? Part II

As a psychotherapist you have probably heard references to the "standard of care" or the "reasonably competent therapist," but you may not have a clear understanding of how such concepts affect you on a day-to-day basis. Consequently, you may not have an accurate understanding of what the law expects of you as a psychotherapist.
