Why Codependents Can Be Harder to Treat than Addicts

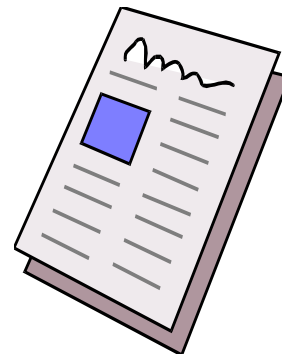

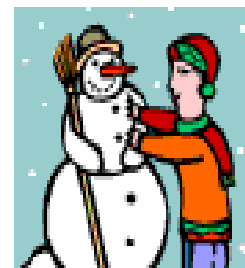
